SUSPENSION ORDER

On this day came the above styled matter before the Arkansas Insurance Commissioner, Jimmy Harris (“Commissioner”). The Arkansas Insurance Department (“AID”) was represented by John Taylor Caldwell, Jr., Associate Counsel, in this matter. From the facts and law before the Commissioner, he finds and concludes as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. John Koller, (“Respondent,”) holds a resident producer license, NPN 16392975, and is a resident of Pearcy.
2. On April 29, 2026, AID received notice from the Arkansas Office of Child Support Enforcement (“OCSE”) that Respondent is three (3) or more months in arrearage on his child support obligations, thereby directing AID to suspend any license held by the Respondent.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

From the Findings of Fact contained herein, the Commissioner concludes as follows:


1. The Commissioner has jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 23-61-103.
2. The Commissioner is required by Ark. Code Ann. § 9-14-239(d) to suspend an insurance producer’s license upon notice from OCSE that a licensee is three (3) or more months in arrears on a child support obligation.

3. Under the provisions of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(14), the failure to comply with an order imposing child support obligations is grounds for suspension or revocation of an insurance producer license. As described above, Respondent is in violation of Ark. Code Ann. § 23-64-512(a)(14).

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Respondent John Koller's producer license, NPN 16392975, is hereby SUSPENDED. During the term of this suspension, Respondent shall not conduct the business of insurance in the State of Arkansas. This Order shall be rescinded upon receiving proof from OCSE that Respondent is in full compliance with his obligations under any child support order.
